My name is Tyler Chambliss, and I work stateside in Jackson, MS, with an organization called The Hard Places Community.

The Hard Places Community (HPC) is an international group of like-minded believers in Jesus Christ whose mission is to see justice prevail, pain redeemed, hope reborn and life restored in the hearts of those the world deems to be the most broken. They carry out this mission mainly in Cambodia, with exciting opportunities for the future in other parts of the world. The men, women and children that are protected and ministered to through HPC have been touched by the tragic operation of sex trafficking.

HPC has several locations and ministries within Cambodia with a staff made up of 30 Cambodian men and women who have dedicated their lives to the cause of bringing light into darkness. The salaries for these workers are funded by kind hearted individuals from all over the world who hear about the cause and choose not to turn a blind eye.

Dine Against Darkness Serve Planning

Wednesday, November 7th:

-Set up team from 5 until probably 8 or 9. - We'll need help setting up the tables, putting up the plastic sheeting to block the light and decorating.

-Servers - those serving Thursday night will need to be at Hal and Mal's at 5 for a quick 45 minute- hour training session. If someone wants to serve food, but can't make it to this meeting, we can still let them do it but only if the majority of people can come.

Thursday, November 8th:

-Set Up Team - 1-5 - whatever set up is left. Mostly setting the tables and any last minute stuff we might need. This will depend how much gets done Wednesday, but there is always something to be done just about.

-Serve Team - 5-9:30+ - we'll need at least 1-2 people per table plus a few folks to bus the tables to make everything run smoothly. These folks would need to wear all black (or at least super dark denim). They will be the ones to help people get seated, serve appetizers in the first room, run all the plates for each course, refill drinks, and clean off the tables.

-Tear Down Team - 9-11ish - These will be people that help us get everything taken down and cleaned up after the event. If the Servers wish to stay then that is awesome, but if anyone can't come until late then this gives them an option.
